



## Ultra Thin Bluetooth Keyboard for iPad 2,3,& 4

### HOW TO SETUP BLUETOOTH KEYBOARD

**PLEASE NOTE:** Since the update of IOS 7.0, the Photo Gallery shortcut key is not functioning, whereas it did function under IOS 6.xx. This is something that is out of the control of Digital Gadgets and a future update from Apple, might resolve this issue.

#### CHARGING

Plug the USB cable into the Bluetooth keyboard, then into the white wall adaptor that came with the iPad.  
Plug the wall adaptor into a wall outlet letting it charge for at least an hour.  
A red light below the battery icon will illuminate. (a full charge will take 4 to 6 hours).  
Keep the keyboards power switch (pictured below) in the off position. (OFF= O, ON= I)

1. On the bottom right side of the keyboard you will notice the following icons:



2. To turn on these items, you will need to locate the switch and button on the bottom right side of the keyboard directly below these icons.

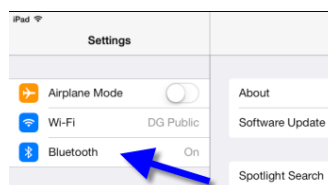


\*Note the Power is on the left and is a **Switch** that moves right and left, whereby the Bluetooth is a **Button** that can only be pushed in. **DO NOT TRY AND MOVE THE BUTTON UP/DOWN/FORWARD/BACK.**

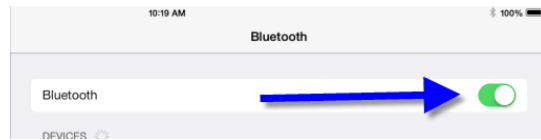
3. Next, prepare your iPad to connect to the keyboard.



- a. Turn on your iPad so that you can access the "SETTINGS" icon. Tap this icon once.
- b. This will open up the Settings Screen, whereby you are looking for the word "Bluetooth" which should be on the left side of your screen. Click on the word "Bluetooth".



- c. Make sure the Bluetooth is “On” if “Off” then slide the on screen button to the right.



4. Next turn on the keyboard by using the power switch on the keyboard. You will notice a blue light turned on and then quickly goes away by the Bluetooth icon. This is normal and is showing the keyboard turned on but **DOES NOT** mean it is in pairing mode.

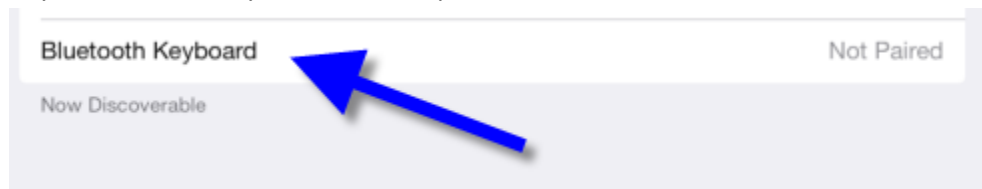


5. Next, push on the Bluetooth button on the keyboard until you see a flashing light next to the Bluetooth icon.

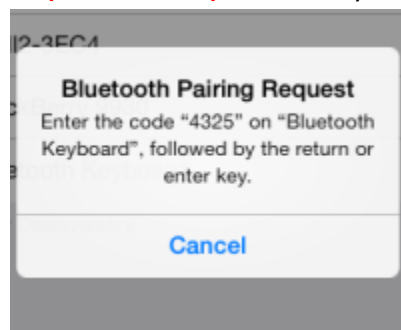
**This indicates the unit is ready to pair.**



6. Once the keyboard is sending a Bluetooth signal, you will see the name “BLUETOOTH KEYBOARD” on the list of available Bluetooth devices on your iPad. \*Note you are still not paired with this device.\*



7. Click on this line and follow the instruction prompt that shows on the screen. (This will be an iPad prompt asking you to type a 4 digit code on the Bluetooth keyboard (**not the iPad**) followed by clicking on the “return or enter” key.



8. If done correctly, you will see the word “Connected” on the Bluetooth Keyboard line.














