

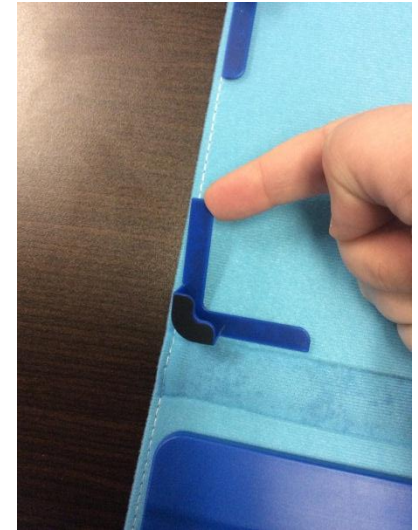

Your Universal Bluetooth Keyboard Case comes with 4 removable and customizable velcro clips that allow you to position almost any tablet or smartphone to use the Bluetooth function of the keyboard.

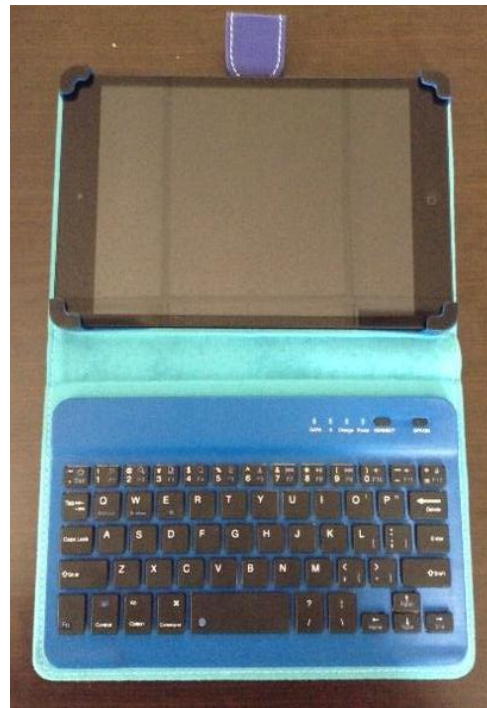


To remove the velcro clips, lift gently at one end of the clip. Pull gently until the clip is fully removed from the felt backing. Place the clip off to the side of the Universal Keyboard Case. Repeat this step for the three other clips.



If you are using a smaller device, such as a smartphone you will only need two of the clips.

If you are using a larger device, such as a tablet you will use all 4 clips.



With all the clips removed, select the position that you would like to have your tablet or smartphone in.



Now that you have selected where you would like to have your mobile device, slightly move the device up so that you are able to align the clip with the bottom of the device.

Take one clip and place it on the bottom left corner. Repeat step for larger mobile devices.



Slide your smartphone back down into the clip(s) that you have placed on the backing.

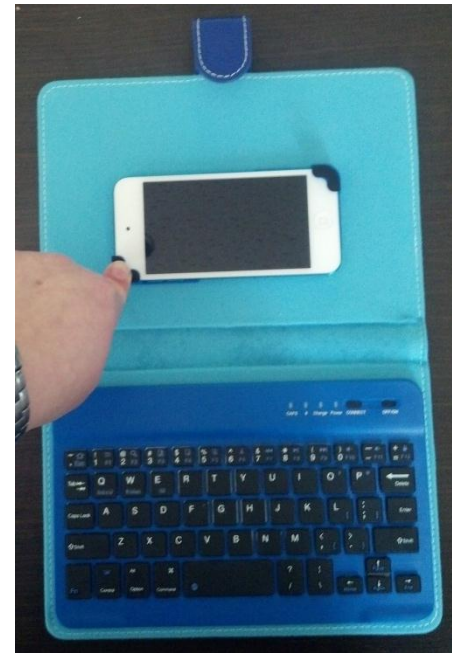


Lift up the right corner of the your device and slip another clip underneath the top right corner of your mobile device. Repeat for left side for larger mobile devices.



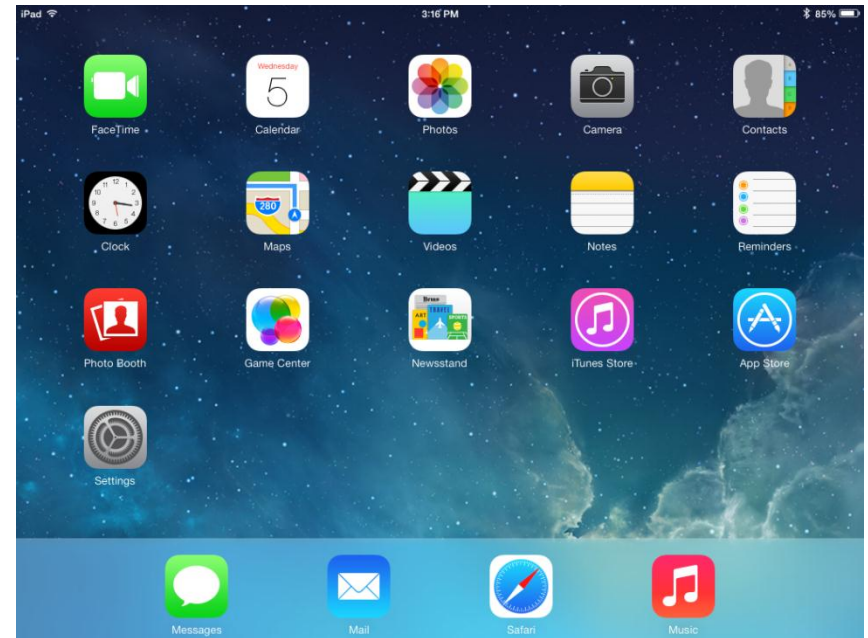
Press down on all clips firmly to ensure that the mobile device is secured.

You are now ready to pair your smartphone with the Bluetooth keyboard.



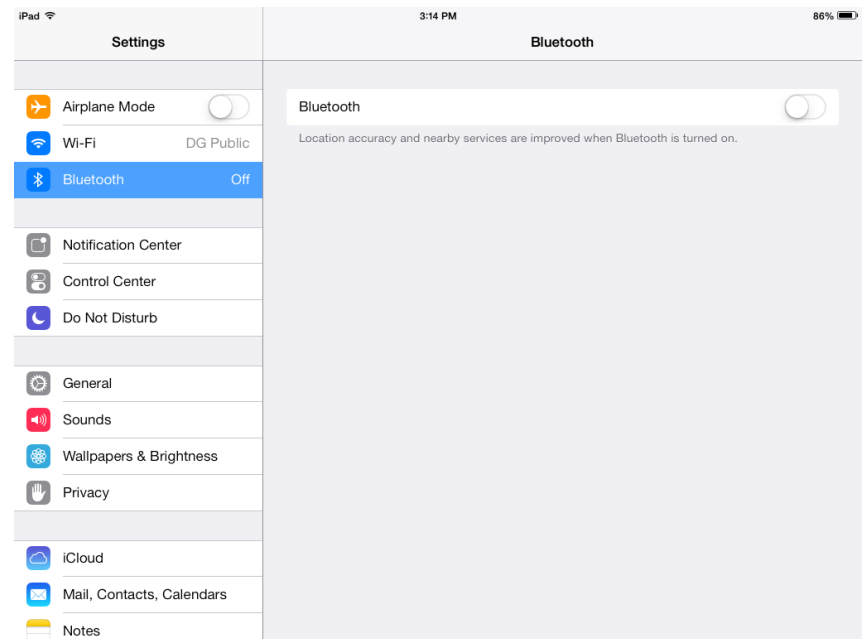
PAIRING YOUR APPLE DEVICE TO THE BLUETOOTH KEYBOARD

On the home screen of your Apple smartphone or tablet, select the “Settings” application.



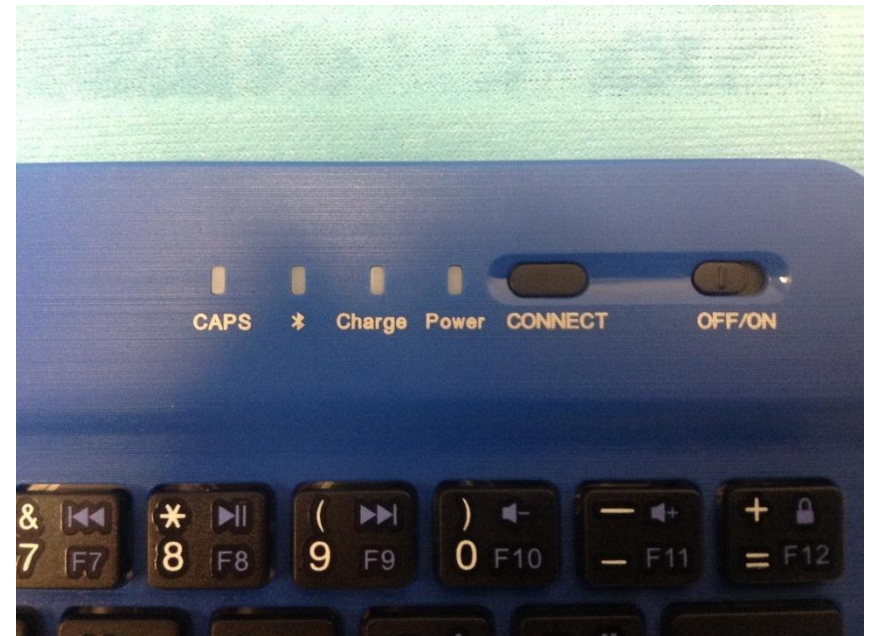
In the “Settings” application, select Bluetooth on the left hand side.

If it shows that Bluetooth is turned “Off”, turn it on.



On your Bluetooth keyboard, move the switch into the “ON” position. A blue light above “POWER” will light up for 2 to 3 seconds.

Press the “CONNECT” button. You will see the Bluetooth symbol light flash.

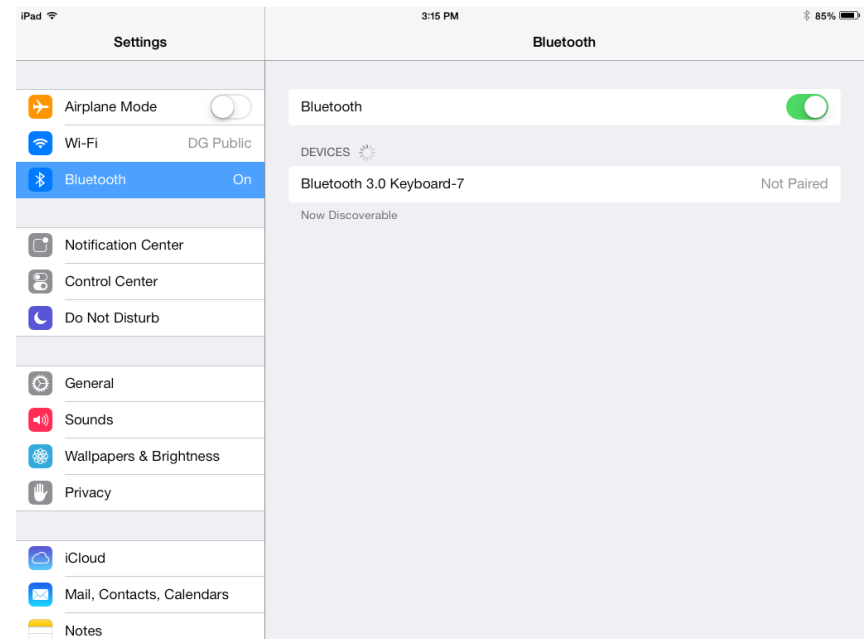


You will see the Universal Bluetooth Keyboard appear under the *Devices* section on the screen.

It shows that the Bluetooth keyboard is *Not Paired*.

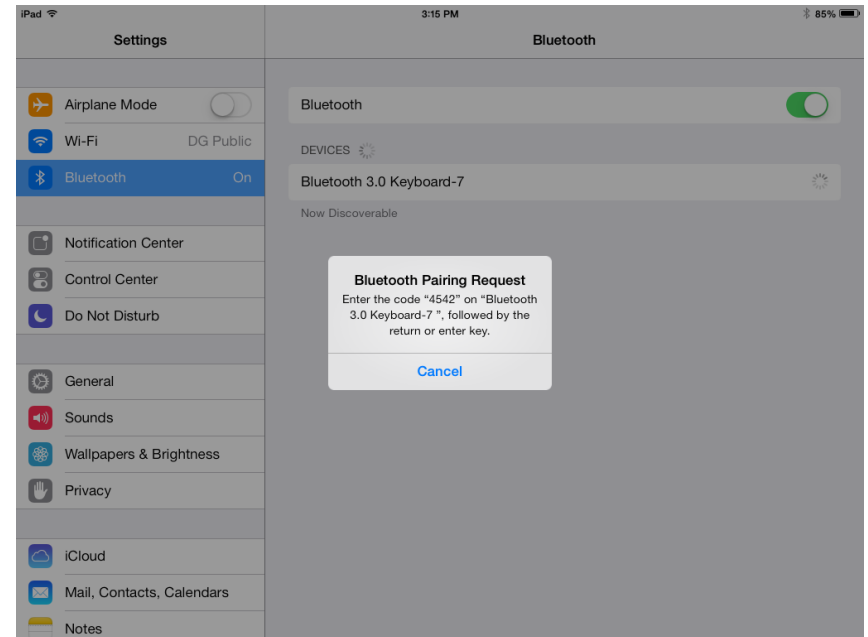
Bluetooth 3.0 Keyboard-7 is for the 7" Universal Bluetooth Keyboard.

Bluetooth 3.0 Keyboard-10 is for the 10" Universal Bluetooth Keyboard.

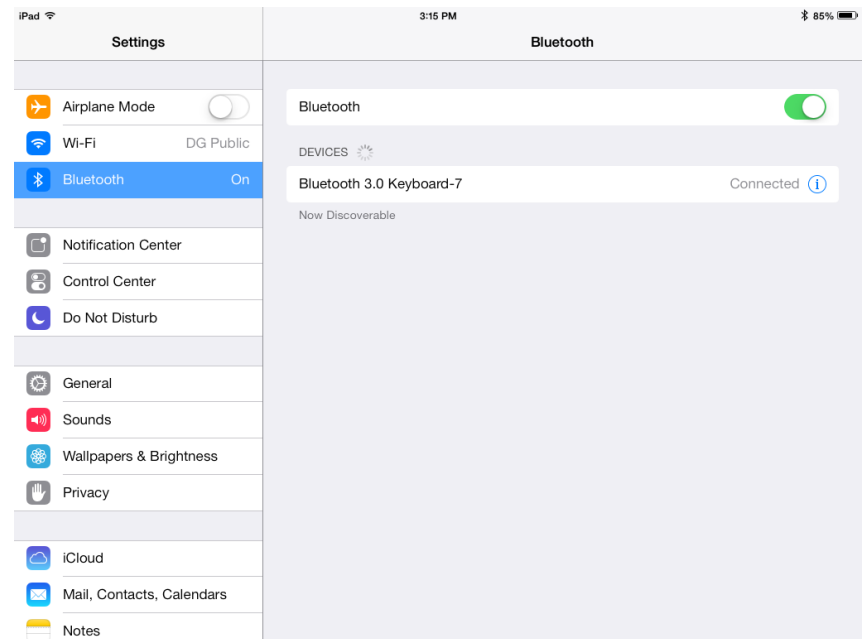


A passcode will appear on the screen.

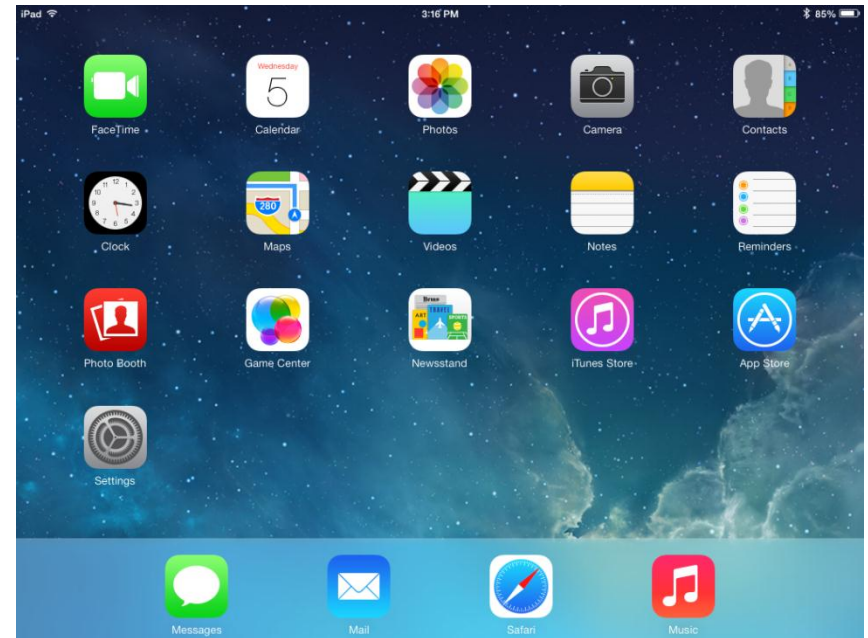
Enter the 4 digit number using the number keys on the Bluetooth keyboard followed by the enter sign.



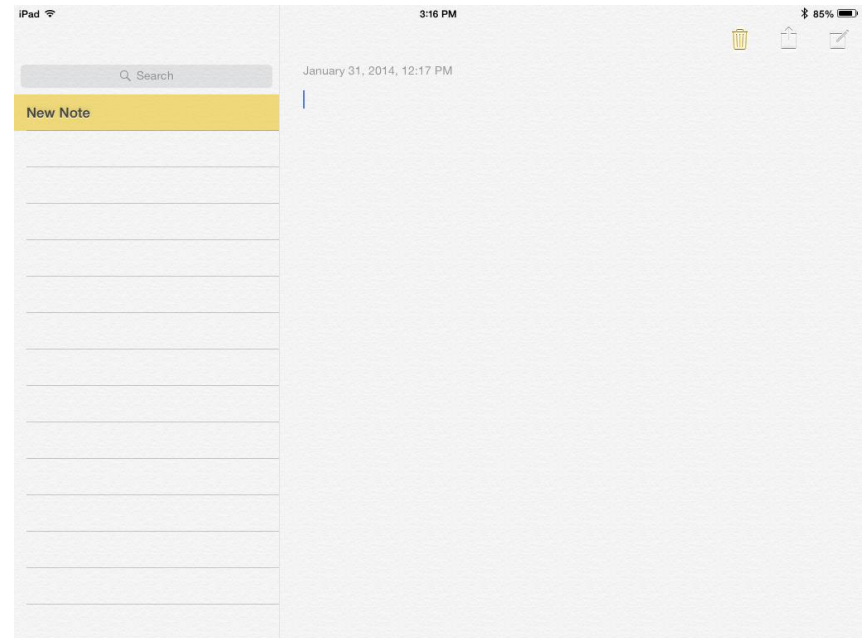
On your screen, you will see that the Bluetooth keyboard is listed as *Connected*.



Now that you have successfully paired your Bluetooth keyboard with your Apple device, go back to the Home Screen and select the “Notes” application.



In the “Notes” application tap on the right hand side to have the cursor appear.



Using the Bluetooth keyboard, type a phrase to make sure that all keys are working properly.
